LOWER DIVISION MATHEMATICS COURSES

Enrollment will be very limited in <u>Math 1, Math 3A, Math 3B, Math 3C, Math 31A, Math 31B, Math 32A, and Math 33A</u> at the request of New Student Orientation to accommodate an unusually large incoming class. Continuing students are strongly encouraged to enroll into these classes during their first pass if you really need it. ALL UNUSED SEATS THAT WE HAVE SET ASIDE FOR CONTINUING STUDENTS (with the exception of Math 1, Math 3A and Math 31A due to the diagnostic test) WILL BE <u>GIVEN TO THE INCOMING CLASS ON THURSDAY, JULY 11, 2013</u> (two week after second pass begins).

During first pass, continuing students will only be able to enroll into Discussion E and Discussion F until it reaches the discussion capacity with the exception of Math 3C and Math 33A. For Math 3C and Math 33A ONLY, continuing students will only be able to enroll into Discussion A to D until the discussion capacity is reached. The capacities are true and waitlists are real, meaning that the only way to move up the waitlist and into a class is by other people dropping out of the specific discussion section. There are no plans to go beyond the lecture capacity of 210. We DO NOT give out PTE numbers and we cannot predict how many people will be dropping and when. There are generally some people that drop the course at the beginning of the quarter, so we do expect to see some movement. Once orientation ends, ALL students can add into any discussion beginning Tuesday, September 17, 2013 (we do not know the time) as long the capacity is below 35.

To prevent incoming students from taking seats that are set aside for continuing students, enrollment capability into Discussion E and F (A to D for Math 3C and Math 33A only) will be closed during the enrollment period of the incoming students (http://www.newstudents.ucla.edu/firstyearstudents.htm#dates).

UPPER DIVISION MATHEMATICS COURSES

Please note that upper division math courses are restricted to math major and minors only during the first pass; it is open to all majors during the second pass (with a few exceptions).

If an upper division course is full we cannot allow any more students into the class until someone drops. We urge students to frequently check URSA to see if any students have dropped. Instructors do not have control over course enrollment in this department. If you are unable to enroll into the class by the first day of class:

For upper division math courses - you can place your name on the unofficial waitlist (http://droopy.math.ucla.edu/drupal/waitlist) that will not start till the first day of class. There are no guarantees on this unofficial waitlist - PTE numbers will be given out if there is room in the class and based on priority.

EXCEPTIONS due to limited course availability:

<u>Math 115A</u> will have a capacity of 35 seats throughout summer orientation. Once orientation ends, <u>ALL students can add into any discussion beginning Tuesday</u>, <u>September 17, 2013 (we do not know the time)</u> as long the capacity is below 40.

Math 164 will have a capacity of 35 seats until summer orientation enrollment begins on Thursday, July 11, 2013 (two week after second pass begins). For those who were unable to enroll on their own during first and second pass, we are only allowing students who meet both of the following criteria in the course first: registered UCLA students who are declared Math/Econ major and graduating in Fall 2013 (we will be checking records!). IF AND ONLY IF you fall under this category, please email ugrad@math.ucla.edu with your name, student ID number and your request with the subject header "Fall 2013 Math 164 Enrollment" (do not email the instructor directly about enrollment). Once orientation enrollment begins, ALL students can add into any discussion beginning Tuesday, September 17, 2013 (we do not know the time) as long the capacity is below 40.

<u>Math 172A</u> will be restricted to Actuarial majors only throughout summer orientation. Once orientation ends, <u>ALL students can add into any discussion beginning Tuesday, September 17, 2013 (we do not know the time) as long the capacity is below 40.</u>

TO ALL STUDENTS NO MATTER WHAT YOUR SITUATION IS

No matter what your situation is, if a course is full, we cannot allow any more students into the class until someone drops. Lower and upper division discussion capacities are set and will remain at 35 and 40, respectively. We urge students to frequently check URSA to see if any students have dropped. Instructors do not have control over course enrollment in this department. If you are unable to enroll into the class by the first day of class, you should attend lecture and let the instructor and TA know of your situation in hopes that they will keep and grade your work while you are waiting for a spot to open. You should have a backup plan nonetheless.
